Joint air exercises with Singapore on

New Delhi, November 8 Indian Air Force MiG-27 and MiG-21 Bisons and Singapore Air Force F-16 jets began joint exercises today at the showpiece Kalaikunda airbase in West Bengal. This is the third such exercise between India and Singapore, according to official sources. The IAF had earlier pitted its frontline jets like the Sukhoi-30, Mirage-2000 and other fighter aircraft against the F-16s during its previous exercise with the Singapore Air Force, the US Air Force and the Thai Air Force.

MiG-29 crashes near Jamnagar base, pilot safe

Ahmedabad, Nov. 22 (PTI): A MiG-29 fighter of the Indian Air Force on Tuesday crashed near the airbase in Jamnagar shortly after taking off for a routine sortie and the pilot ejected to safety. Barring some minor injuries, the pilot is safe and he is being taken to the IAF hospital for treatment, an official source said. The crash occurred at around 7.45 p.m in the vicinity of Sarmat village soon after the jet had taken off for a routine night sortie.
